Background

I became a consultant in the NHS at West Lambeth and a senior lecturer at Guys' and St Thomas' London in 1987, working as Consultant and Medical Director, before moving to be Professor & Head of Department at the University of Sheffield in 1995 and later at the University of Kent. I retired from the NHS in 2013, but remain Emeritus Professor in Kent.

I am a psycho-pharmacologist with extensive expertise in most psychiatric drugs and have worked in and with the pharmaceutical industry to develop drugs for many mental health conditions, most recently as Medical Director of a Japanese/US company.
